

# ORDINANCE

## CITY OF FEDERAL DAM ORDINANCE No. 2006-7-10 Amended 2006-8-14

### AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CONTROL OF DOGS WITHIN CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Federal Dam has determined that all dogs belonging to residents of the City of Federal Dam shall not be a public nuisance, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is a nuisance for any dog to habitually or frequently bark or cry at night, to chase vehicles, to molest or annoy any person away from the Lot of his Owner or custodian, or to damage, defile, or destroy property. Habitual or frequent barking or crying occurs if it exceeds 15 minutes in duration including quiet interludes of 3 minutes or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Federal Dam, Cass County, State of Minnesota, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. After reasonable notice to the owner of the dog(s), The Cass County Sheriff's Department will be notified of any dog(s) found running at large and shall give notice to the owner of such dog(s), if known.

Section 2. After reasonable notice to the owner of the dog(s), The Cass County Sheriff's Department will be notified of any habitual barking of dog(s) and shall give notice to the owner of such dog(s), if know.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
